### SevOne looks overseas

SevOne Inc., the Newark, Del., firm that tracks digital traffic for Comcast, says Osage Ventures, the Philadelphia firm headed by ex-**Wolf Block** partner turned tech, health-care and retail investor Robert S. Adelson, agreed last week to raise "several million dollars" so "we can launch this company in our Europe, Middle East and Asia markets," says SevOne president Michael Phelan.

Osage also invested in SevOne last year, along with SunGard founder John Ryan, among others.

Multinationals like Thomson Reuters and Credit Suisse already use SevOne to track network and application performance and customer and employee usage. Phelan says he wants to be able to support them in the field, not just from his 30-person headquarters near the University of Delaware.
